Guidelines:

- Entries close 5pm **Friday 23 July 2010**.
- Haiku should be typed or clearly handwritten on an A4 page and either delivered or mailed to The Bodhi Tree, 1/416-418 Oxford St, Mt Hawthorn WA 6016.
- Open to poets residing in the Perth metro area only.
- Haiku should not have been previously published (including on the web or broadcast).
- Up to 3 haiku maximum per poet.
- Entry fee: \$5 for 3 haiku or \$4 for 2 haiku, or \$2 for 1 haiku.
- Cheques and money orders should be made payable to *The Bodhi Tree*.
- Any entry not accompanied by the correct entry fee will be disqualified.
- Entrants send cash at their own risk.
- Winners announced at The Bodhi Tree on Sunday afternoon **1 August 2010**.
- Judges will be looking for the 'aha' factor.

2nd Prize – *Haiku Mind: 108 poems to cultivate awareness & open your heart*

3rd Prize – *The British Museum Haiku*
